Weekly Reminders:

1. Regular practice for all teams tonight - Happy President's Day!
2. Reminder the competition for this weekend is held at Mountain View High School which off of Lindsay and just north of Brown Rd. in Mesa. Hot Stuff, Burn, and Sizzle will need to be there at 2PM. Back Draft, Illuminate, and Phoenix will need to be at the competition at 6PM.
3. We do need team member and any parents that can help with the floor and working the competition. We would like any Hot Stuff and Sizzle parents and strong team members that can meet at the gym at 7AM to help get the floor loaded to move to the competition. We need Burn team members and any parents that can help put down the spring floor at 2PM. We need Back Draft, Illuminate, and Phoenix team members and parents to help pull up the floor and put it back down at the gym after the competition is over.
